- **HISTORY:** Celebrating its 53rd year, Andersonville Midsommarfest is one of Chicago’s premier street festivals.
- **LOCATION:** 5200 N. Clark Street @ Foster, Chicago
- **MUSIC:** 5 stages with 50+ multi-genre acts from cover bands, to ethnic dance troupes and drag shows performing over three days
- **AUDIENCE DESCRIPTION:** Being one of the most diverse festivals in Chicago, each year over 50,000 people descend upon Clark Street. The audience ranges from young families, singles to LGBTQ+ Ages 20-50 years old that travel from all across Illinois to enjoy a fun summer weekend.
- **EVENT COMPONENTS:** local artisans and merchants selling their handcrafted wares and unique products, and a large children’s area featuring all-age entertainment. Beer sales benefit local non-profits instilling the sense of community throughout the weekend.
